During your Course you will be required to complete 2 assignments (an Emergency Assistance Plan and a Dive Site Mapping Project) – details will be provided on the first day of your course.

GENERAL

The Divemaster Course is a performance based programme, structured around 3 primary areas:-

Knowledge Development with independent home study

Water Skills and Stamina Tests

Practical Application (including completing PADI's 20 basic skills to demonstration standard (level 3 or greater)

Knowledge Development covers 12 topics:-

- The role and characteristics of a Divernaster
- 2 Supervising diving activities for certified divers
- 3 Assisting with student divers in training
- 4 Dive theory
- 5 Physics
- 6 Physiology
- 7 Equipment
- 8 Decompression theory and dive tables
- 9 Divemaster programmes
- 10 Risk Management
- 11 Business of Diving
- 12 Furthering your dive career

During your Course you will sit a total of 8 examinations where you will be required to achieve a minimum 75% pass mark (IMPORTANT:- The first 3 exams must be completed prior to contact with students and subject to having completed the Knowledge Reviews covering these areas, these exams will be sat on TBA)

- 1 Divemaster programmes
- 2 Supervising Certified Divers
- 3 Assisting Student Dives in Training
- 4 Physics
- 5 Physiology
- 6 Equipment
- 7 Decompression theory and dive tables
- 8 Skills and the Environment

Stamina Tests:-

You will be required to complete the following stamina tests and achieve a combined score of not less than 12 for the 4 tests.

400 metre swim test —(under 6 minutes-5 points. 6-8 min-4 points. 8-10 min-3. 10-12-2 points. Over 12 mins-1 point. Stopped-0 points.

15 minutes tread water – (in the last 2 minutes hands to be raised out of water) – (Satisfactory-5 points. Stayed afloat but hands not out of water-3 points. Used side of pool for support not more than twice-1 point. Used side of pool more than twice-0 points.)

800 metre snorkel swim – (under 14 minutes-5 points. 14-16 mins, 30 secs-4 points. 16 mins, 30 secs – 18 mins, 30 secs-3 points. 18 mins, 30 secs-21 mins-2 points. More than 21 mins-1 point. Incompleted-0 points.)

100 metre diver tow – (Under 2 mins, 10 secs-5 points. 2 mins, 10 secs-3 mins, 15 secs-4 points. 3 mins, 15 secs-4 mins, 20 secs-3 points. 4 mins, 20 secs-5 mins, 30 secs-2 points. More than 5 mins, 30 secs-1 point. Incomplete-0 points.)


DIRECTIONS to The NDC (Approx 125 miles - 200 km from Maidstone).:-

Take the M4 West and continue past Junction 20 - Turn onto the M48 towards Chepstow and Services - Cross the Severn and Wye Bridges and turn off at Junction 2 - Take the second exit A466 towards Chepstow and Tintern - Turn right onto the A48 at the next roundabout and continue into Chepstow. Continue through Chepstow on the A48 towards Gloucester, the National Diving & Activity Centre is 1.2 miles outside Chepstow on the left hand side.

DIRECTIONS to Guildenburgh (Approx 121.2 miles - 195.1 km from Maidstone).:-

M11 for 41.4 miles (43.4 miles - 69.8 km). Continue straight ahead onto A14 for 16.9 miles (84.8 miles - 136.4 km). Exit to the left onto Slip Road for 0.3 miles (101.7 miles - 163.6 km). At the roundabout, take the third exit onto B1043 for 0.1 miles (102 miles - 164.1 km). At the roundabout, take the first exit onto B1043 for 3.7 miles (102.1 miles - 164.2 km). At the roundabout, take the second exit onto B1043 for 0.8 miles (105.8 miles - 170.2 km). At the roundabout, take the second exit onto B1043 Old North Road for 0.5 miles (106.5 miles - 171.4 km). At the roundabout, take the second exit onto B1043 Old North Road for 0.4 miles 107 miles (172.1 km). At the roundabout, take the first exit onto B1043 for 1.6 miles (107.4 miles - 172.8 km). Turn right for 0.1 miles 109 miles (175.4 km). Turn right onto B660 Glatton Ways for 5.9 miles (109.1 miles - 175.6 km). Turn left onto B1040 Herne Road for 5.9 miles (115.1 miles - 185.2 km). At the roundabout, take the third exit onto A605 Syers Lane for 0.3 miles (120.9 miles -194.6 km). At the roundabout, take the second exit onto A605 Eastrea Road for 1.2 miles (121.2 miles - 195.1 km). Arrive at Guildenburgh.

DIRECTIONS to Stoney Cove (Approx 142.1 miles - 228.7 km from Maidstone):-



Continue on M1 for 57.7 miles (67.5 miles - 108.6 km) Exit at J18 for 0.2 miles. At the roundabout, take the first exit onto A428 for 0.3 miles. At the roundabout, take the first exit onto A5 for 0.6 miles. At the roundabout, take the third exit onto A5 for 5 miles. At the roundabout, take the second exit onto A5 for 2.3 miles. At the roundabout, take the second exit onto A5 for 4.7 miles.

Turn right onto B4114 for 3 miles (138.3 miles - 222.6 km). Turn left onto Sharnford

Road for 0.6 miles (141.3 miles). Turn left onto B4669 Leicester Road for 0.2 miles (141.9 miles - 228.4 km). Turn left onto Dovecote Close for 0 miles (142.1 miles - 228.7 km). Arrive at Stoney Cove
